From the Senior Deacon - Brother David Renner

I am the great grandson of Brother Winfred Knott Renner Sr. and grandson of Winfred Knott Renner Jr. both of whom were raised in the Manchester Lodge. Although I personally didn't know either of them, I was told that my great grandfather was a very spiritual man and a great man of faith. This is evident BRO, GARY GEORGE VITEK in his commitment to lead Hymn Sings all over Richmond and he even traveled to West Virginia to conduct in the 60's which I got hear on a reel to reel player.

Like many of you, I had often heard that Masonry was a cult. I knew that if my great grandfather was a part of the Masons then what I was hearing couldn't be true. It was the spiritual aspects of Masonry that that drew me to knock on the west gate of Ashland Lodge 168 four years ago. When my three distinct knocks were answered by a like number from within with the question "Who comes there?" and my name was given, I was filled with emotions I will never forget. I was in awe that I was going through the same thing as my grandfathers went through. Once I was brought to light and beheld the Holy Bible, Square, and Compasses laying on the altar in the center of lodge it solidified I was in the right place as I was surrounded by brothers of faith.

The Holy Bible's contents can be discovered in all aspects of Masonry. They can be found from the catechisms, floor work, all the way to opening and closing of a lodge. Did you know that the prayer given at the grave in the second part of the Master Mason's Degree comes directly from Psalm 139 and Job 14? The beginning of the prayer can be found in Psalm 139 verses 2 through 4 while the rest is taken from Job 14. In the first of part of the prayer taken from Psalm 139, David teaches us that the Creator knows us intimately. God's knowledge is thorough. It is perfect and God knows our moral qualities and what motivates us. In Job 14, Job seems to be asking the Great Architect of the Universe to take away the affliction he is experiencing so that he can find rest. Job seems to understand that if it is his last days that only God knows the day and time when we will leave this life to that "undiscovered country from whose bourne no traveler returns". This is not a prayer for God to turn away from him because of the ending that is found here, "Have compassion on the children of Thy Creation. Administer comfort in the time of trouble". It seems to be a prayer for the Giver of all good gifts and graces to take away the sufferings that come from times of trouble. There is also a hint of resurrection in the prayer at the grave and is also displayed in the raising of the body.

Discovering these kinds of connection to the Holy Bible is what draws me to Masonry. The Holy Bible and it's contents are the rule and guide of our faith. The contents of the rule and guide of our faith can be found in the several compartments of Masonry. For me, it is fun to discover. "Seek and you shall find, ask and it will be given."
