Masonic Education Corner

Most of you know that Masonry's spiritual and Biblical connections brought me to the West Gate. Masonry encourages us to think about our mortality. One of the working tools of the Entered Apprentice and one of the working tools of a Fellowcraft help us to achieve this. Their explanations are closely related to what we find in the Holy Bible, which is the rule and guide of our faith.

As you well know, the common gavel is used "for the more noble and glorious purpose of divesting our hearts and consciences of all the vices and superfluities of life; thereby fitting our minds, as living stones, for that spiritual building, that house not made with hands-eternal in the heavens." The level "teaches us all that we are traveling on the broad level of time to that undiscovered country from whose bourne no traveler returns." These tools should assure us that life continues after our time here on earth for those who are faithful 'til the end.

When God introduced himself to Moses in Exodus 3: 6. God said, "I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." When Jesus was challenged on the subject of resurrection by the Sadducees, who didn't believe in it, He referenced what God said in Exodus to prove and bring assurance that resurrection was a reality. He explained that God introduced Himself this way because God was the God of the living and not the dead. God said, "I am," not that "I was" the God of these men. These men were already gone from this planet, yet God referred to Himself as their God in the present tense. They were still living.
